

Notice Regarding Minn. Stat. § 268.095 and Unemployment Benefits

Please review this document carefully as eligibility for unemployment benefits may be affected.

Minn. Stat. § 268.095, subd. 2(d) provides:

An applicant who, within five calendar days after completion of a suitable temporary job assignment from a staffing service employer, (1) fails without good cause to affirmatively request an additional job assignment, or (2) refuses without good cause an additional suitable job assignment offered, shall be considered to have quit employment.

You required to affirmatively request an additional job assignment within five (5) days of completing or ending a job assignment. If you fail to affirmatively request an additional job assignment, or refuse an additional suitable job assignment, you will be considered to have quit employment with Worldwide Travel Staffing and unemployment benefits may be affected.

To request an additional job assignment, you must submit your request via email to your designated Worldwide Travel Staffing recruiter or call 716-821-9001 between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, and speak directly with your designated recruiter.
